Saturday AUGUST 4th 2018 – Black And Green !
Some dramatic moorland scenery today assuming fair weather. The infamous reputation of Black Hill was well deserved but conservation work has dramatically transformed a black wilderness into a green one. The edge walk above Ramsden Clough is one of the best that the Peak District National Park has to offer. In the event of inclement weather an alternative will be used at low level.

We will ‘weave’ our way through the suburbs of Huddersfield before a sharp climb sees us reach the folly erected on Longwood Edge in 1861. The edge has fine views over the Colne valley as we make our way across to Golcar, a fine example of a weaver’s settlement. Finish here for a bus back into town or carry on down the ‘Golcar Lily Ginnel Trail’ to finish along the narrow canal back into town.

A varied, scenic walk via the Trans Pennine Trail and public rights of way – as part of the East Peak Outdoors Festival.

Saturday JULY 7th 2018 – Tea At The Mill !

Supporting the Saturdays-only limited train service on the ‘Brigg Line’ we follow the River Ancholme to Hibaldstow then across field paths to Mount Pleasant windmill for afternoon tea! (return train dep. Kirton Lindsey 15.52 all stations Sheffield)

Start: 9.20am at BRIGG Finish: **KIRTON LINDSEY**

Distance: 8 miles. Leader: Stuart Parker

Depart: Huddersfield 06.12, Barnsley 07.01,

Meadowhall 07.21 to arrive Sheffield 07.29.

Depart: Sheffield 07.55, Worksop 08.26, Retford 08.36,

Road then walk across to Gainsborough CENTRAL station next to Marshall’s Yard to catch the 08.57 train to BRIGG.

Saturday JULY 21st 2018 – Over The Water To Skye !

We travel from the Don to the Little Don, using two sets of stepping stones on this walk, unless water level is too high. New footpaths added to the Definitive Map help us traverse the ridge before the descent to journey’s end.

(return by bus No.201 to Chapelton for trains to Huddersfield or No.57 to Sheffield or No.SL1 to Middlewood tramstop P&R)
