

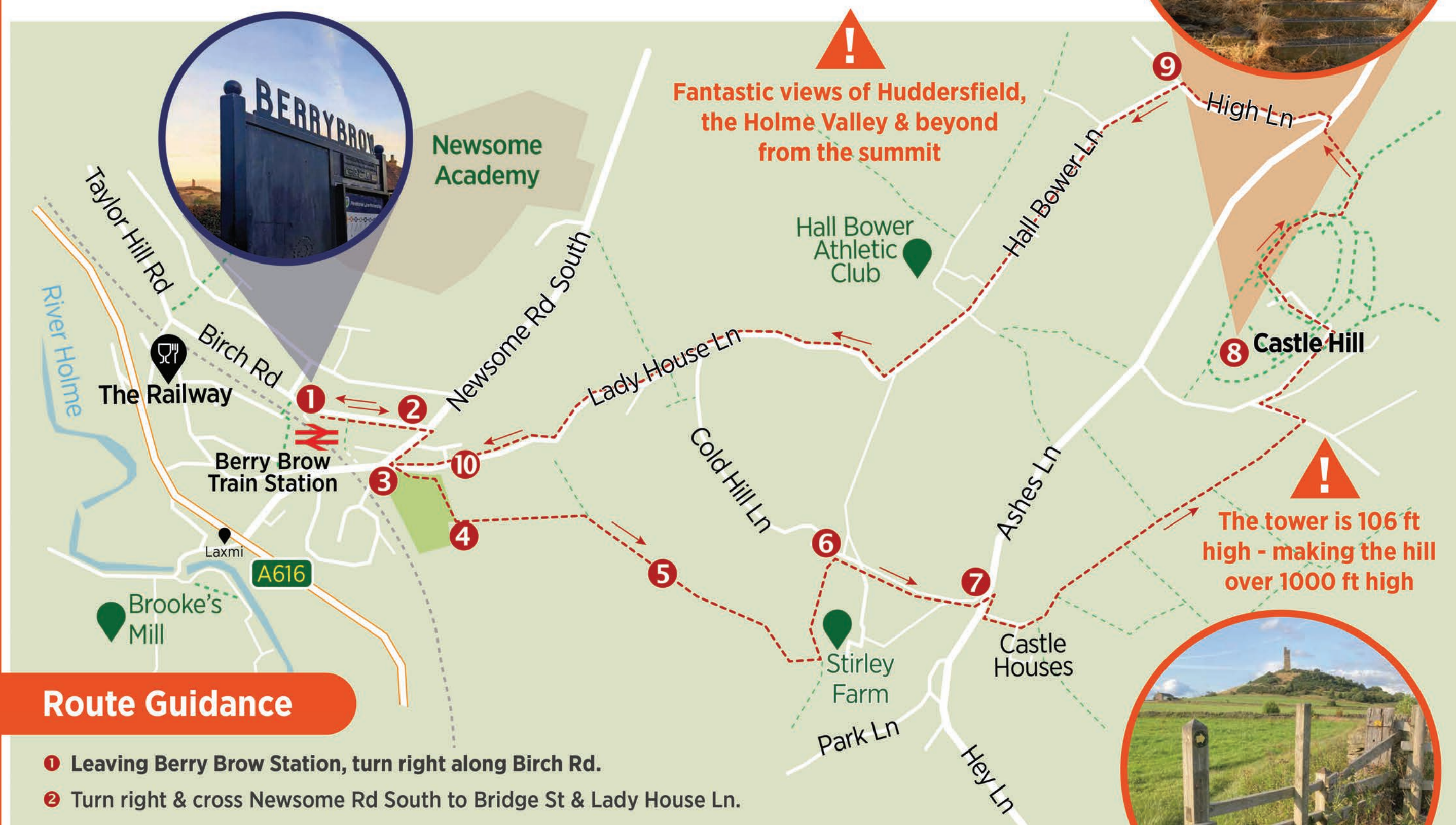
Berry Brow Station to Castle Hill

WALK to an Iron Age Hillfort, prominent landmark & ancient monument - the Grade II Listed Victoria Tower - 3 miles/4.8 km



Route Guidance

- 1 Leaving Berry Brow Station, turn right along Birch Rd.
- 2 Turn right & cross Newsome Rd South to Bridge St & Lady House Ln.
- 3 At playing field, enter via gap in wall, (or stone steps further up Lady House Ln. Keep left to the upper perimeter of field to reach a gate in the top left corner.
- 4 Follow the footpath to a kissing gate & continue straight up. At a 3 way junction, continue straight up again, heading towards the terrace of houses on the skyline.
- 5 Keep heading up towards the houses along a grassy track. Just before Stirley Farm, turn left, keeping the farm on your right & soon reach Cold Hill Lane.
- 6 Turn right here & continue uphill on the rough track to reach Hey Ln.
- 7 Cross the road & turn right (narrow pavement), then left after a short distance onto Castle Houses. Beyond the houses, go through a gap in two field gates in the left corner, with fine views of Victoria Tower now straight ahead. Take the left path over the stile heading towards Victoria Tower & cross a number of fields until you reach the road. Turn left at Lumb Ln on to Castle Hill Side, then turn 2nd right up the bridleway or continue for steps to the summit (sometimes closed off).
- 8 After exploring Castle Hill, leave via the opposite (northern) end footpath which descends on a paved path to Ashes Ln, cross carefully onto High Ln.
- 9 Descend to Hall Bower School & turn left onto Hall Bower Ln, which becomes Lady House Ln after sharp right bend at Hall Bower.
- 10 Continue down to our start route, pass the playing field, turn right onto Newsome Rd South, then left onto Birch Rd to return to the Station on your left.

The tower is 106 ft high - making the hill over 1000 ft high



For refreshments, The Railway pub can be found a few minutes walk from Berry Brow Station. Cross the footbridge, pass flats on Wain Brow, continue to School Lane, turn right & The Railway is on the left, just a short distance further along.
