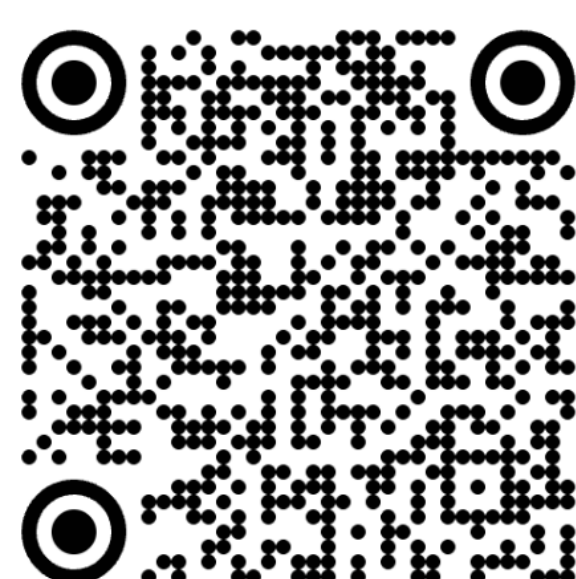

WALKING



- Left out of Brockholes Station - walk downhill to the A616 New Mill Road, turn left & cross at the zebra, take public footpath after Rockhill Road. Pass through Holme Valley Camping & Caravan Park. Cross the River Holme on the footbridge, turn right, after Devour take footpath to the right keeping old mill building to your left. Riverside path passes Thongsbridge Cricket Club.
- At Miry Lane, Thongsbridge, slight right, cross & turn left onto Berry Bank Lane. After ascending here you can take paths descending right, through the woods (caution: steep & often muddy) to Sands Recreation Area / Holmfirth Pool & Leisure Centre. Then continue at the side of the river passing Holmfirth Cricket Club. Cross the road & take steps down to continue on the riverside path, pass the Co-op & Holmside Memorial Gardens, arriving at the Bus & Coach Park in Holmfirth.
- WINTER / ROADSIDE ROUTE: At Berry Bank Lane follow Holme Valley Riverside Way (rather than descending to Sands), pass Holmfirth Fresh Fish, turn right onto the A635. Pass new build houses to descend into Holmfirth on Station Road, pass the Old Stationmaster's House, the Masonic Hall & former site of Bamforth & Co Ltd (known for early film production & "saucy" postcards).

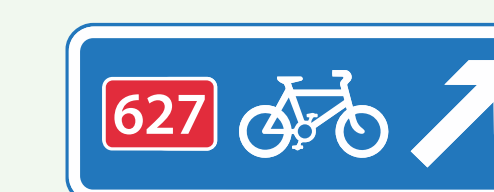

Exit Brockholes Station, turn left, then right at the T-junction to descend to A616 New Mill Road. Turn right & then left at Smithy Place Lane, continue climbing up to Woodhead Road (A6024), turn left & follow for approximately 2 miles to the traffic lights, turning left again here, for Holmfirth town centre.
